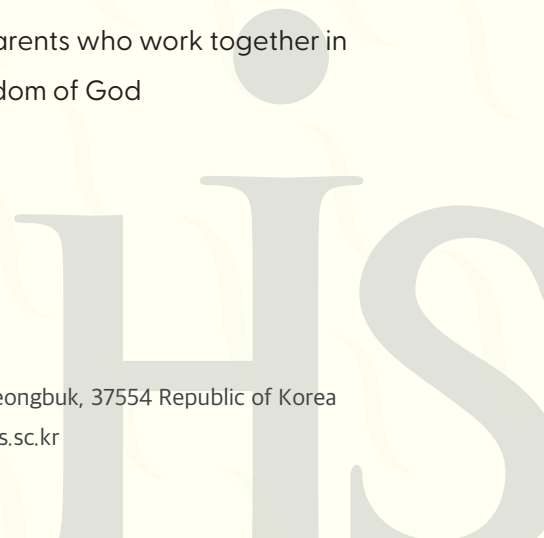


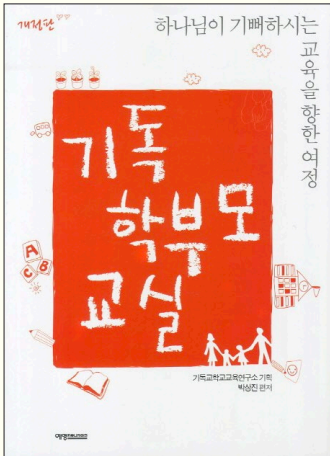
HIS Parents T-Time

Completing "Christian Parent School"

I have joined the HIS community since the year of 2013 when my first daughter transferred to grade 8 at HIS. My younger daughter came to HIS following sister and now my son, the youngest one, is to be in grade 7 at HIS, which makes me a HIS parent for more than 10 years.

I suppose that the reason Christian parents like me choose Christian alternative schools in Korea; where passion for education is so high, is that they want their children to learn from a Biblical perspective and enjoy a happy school life, honoring God through their studies.

However, the college admissions process for two of my children felt like standing before a checkpoint. It made me face the deep motives of myself towards them, on whether I was truly trusting God's plan and acting upon it. I would get confused and frustrated during the process.

The Christian Parent School program was a time that helped me search the worldview I had behind my thoughts and actions through questions and building my identity as a Christian parent.

It also offered a direction to practice, for Christian parents to build their identity by combining their faith and life. Specifically, regardless of being born as a Christian, serving in church ministry, number of years in belief, etc., it meant not chasing after secular standards when deciding on their children's education, workplaces, and marriage.

Seven parents who participated(including Dr. Hae-Kyeong Park) had different backgrounds and talents from God. Nevertheless, we shared a common heart of hoping their children would be used as God had planned toward their unique lives. Every week was a helpful and joyful time when we had conversations on the struggles of raising our children. I was thankful that we could support each other on choosing HIS, a lonely path which we can't make on our own.

We hope that HIS will grow as a genuine Christian school that changes the dark educational reality of Korea as many parents of our school form an educational community that becomes mentors and mentees for each other to establish their identity as Christian parents. We hope that our children here will have a vision of becoming happy workers who seek God's kingdom and righteousness, and we believe that parents, teachers, and God will be co-workers to become the light and salt of the world.
