Handong International School, a Christian alternative school accredited by the Korean Ministry of Education, will conduct admissions for the 2022 Fall Semester as follows.

1. Available Spots

2. Admissions Requirements

- Both the parent(s) and student must be Protestant Christians and consent to the educational philosophy of the school.
- The student must have completed the grade previous to the grade they are applying for, or have received education that is legally equivalent. However, they should not have already completed the year that they are applying for (for example, a student who has already completed 7th grade may not apply for 7th grade again).
- The student must live with at least one parent or grandparent and be able to commute to school.
- The student must be capable of coping with HIS middle or high school education.

- Application results: Tue, July 19, 2022, 14:00
- Interview and Entrance Exam: Tue, July 26, 2022, starting 09:00
- Parent Interviews: Tue, July 26, 2022

B. Evaluation Methods

- **Interview**

- Interviewees will be asked about their understanding of Christianity, spiritual life, school life, relationship with peers, hobbies, plans for studies, and future goals.

C. Types of Admissions

Types of Admissions	Details
General Admissions	- Stage 1: Application & document submission - Stage 2: Interview/Entrance Exam
Special Admissions (Missionary kids & children of employees of HGU Foundation)	- Same screening process as General Admissions

- Applicants that do not fulfill the criteria for Special Admissions will automatically be switched to General Admissions
- Applicants that are not suitable for the education program of the school may not be admitted regardless of availability

8. Notes for Applicants

- Acceptance may be revoked if the contents of the submitted application and documents are found to be falsified.
- Admitted applicants must submit tuition fees during the registration period. Failure to do so may result in revoking admission.
- The school will provide lunch to the student applicants on the day of the interview and entrance exam.
- Submitted documents will not be returned to the applicants.

9. Notes for COVID-19

- ICOVID-19 confirmed patients may be restricted from taking the entrance exams due to the situation in medical institutions and residential treatment centers.
- On Exam Day, students with suspected symptoms of COVID-19, such as a fever of 37.5 degrees or higher, will be held in a separate classroom.
- Students and parents who participated in interviews and exams must contact the school if they are confirmed with COVID-19 within 7 days of the test date.
