



Admissions Information for HIS Middle and High School for 2023 Spring Semester

Handong International School, a Christian alternative school accredited by the Korean Ministry of Education, will conduct admissions for the 2023 Spring Semester as follows.

1. Available Placements

2. Admissions Requirements

- Both the parent(s) and student must be Protestant Christians and consent to the educational philosophy of the school.
- The student must live with at least one parent or grandparent and be able to commute to school OR live in the dormitory*.
- The student must have completed the grade previous to the grade they are applying for, or have received education that is legally equivalent. However, they should not have already completed the year that they are applying for (for example, a student who has already completed 7th grade may not apply for 7th grade again).
- The student must be capable of coping with HIS middle or high school education.
- Missionary kids and grades 9-12 receive priority for dormitory assignments. 7th and 8th graders may be admitted to the dormitories if there is availability.

 - Parent Interviews: Sat, Nov 26, 2022

* After final acceptance, original copies of official school records (transcripts) and certificate of enrollment (or certificate of graduation) must be submitted to the admissions office by the requested deadline. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of admission.

B. Evaluation Methods

- Interviewees will be asked about their understanding of Christianity, spiritual life, school life, relationship with peers, hobbies, plans for studies, and future goals.

Types of Admissions	Details
	- Stage 1: Application & document submission - Stage 2: Interview/Entrance Exam
	- Same screening process as General Admissions

- Applicants that do not fulfill the criteria for Special Admissions will automatically be switched to General Admissions
- Applicants that are not suitable for the education program of the school may not be admitted regardless of availability

8. Notes for Applicants

- A. Acceptance may be revoked if the contents of the submitted application and documents are found to be falsified.
- B. Admitted applicants must submit tuition fees during the registration period. Failure to do so may result in revoking admission.
- C. The school will provide lunch to the student applicants on the day of the interview and entrance exam.
- D. Submitted documents will not be returned to the applicants

9. Notes for COVID-19

- A. If social distancing guidelines are changed due to COVID-19, interviews and evaluation schedules may be postponed.
- B. ICOVID-19 confirmed patients may be restricted from taking the entrance exams due to the situation in medical institutions.
- C. Starting from Nov 21 (Mon), parents should fill out the "Self-diagnosis Survey of Students' Health Status" every day. As soon as you receive a COVID-19 confirmation and quarantine notification, you may be disadvantaged such as cancellation of acceptance if you do not notify the school or make a false notification.
- D. On Exam Day, students with suspected symptoms of COVID-19, such as a fever of 37.5 degrees or higher, will be held in a separate classroom.
- E. Students and parents who participated in interviews and exams must contact the school if they are confirmed with COVID-19 within10 days of the test date.
