



## **2023 -1 MHS Admission Interview and Evaluation Guide for Candidates**

Thank you for applying for the 2023 Handong International School MHS admission examination. Before the interview on 11.26 (Sat), please be aware of the following procedures in accordance with the Gyeongsangbuk-do Office of Education's 『Safety Management Guidelines for Admissions』 for the prevention of COVID-19.

### **1. Cooperation for prevention of COVID-19**

- A. All students and parents must wear a mask. You cannot enter the building without a mask.
- B. Visitors are not allowed to enter the school building, except examinees and parents. Also, parents may enter only during the interview.
- C. Registration for candidates will be from 8:50 - 9:00 am. (Sat) After registration, a student orientation will be held at each written-test room (details will be given on the day).
- D. Parents should enter the main building (Vision Hall) 10 minutes before the parent interview. After sanitizing hands and checking temperature, parents can stay in the waiting room. Please leave the building as soon as the interview ends. The parent interview will last approximately 15 minutes.
- E. Please submit everyday the "Student Health Status Self-Assessment Questionnaire" provided by the school starting on November 11th (Mon.) In case of receiving a confirmation/quarantine notification, please notify the school immediately. An unannounced/false report may result in disadvantages such as cancellation of admission.
- F. A link to the "Student Health Status Self-Assessment Survey" will be sent via text message to the mother's phone number.
- G. On November 26 (Sat) if a candidate has symptoms of COVID-19, such as a fever of 37.5 degrees or higher, the subject evaluation and interview will be held in a separate classroom (detailed notice on the day).
- H. Candidate's temperature check will be done ■ upon registration, ■ upon entering the written-test room, ■ upon completion of the first period evaluation, ■ before lunch, ■ in the waiting room for students during the afternoon.
- I. Lunch will be provided at school only to candidates.
- J. Candidates and parents who participated in the parent interview should contact the school if they are diagnosed with COVID-19 within 10 days of the examination date.

**4 . Notice**

- A. Candidates must wear a mask approved by the Food and Drug Administration (anti-droplet face mask, etc.) and bring two extra masks.
- B. Candidates must bring their cell phones to communicate with their parents after the end of the exam. Candidates will submit their cell phone to the supervisor when they enter the exam room for the 1st period. It will be returned once the evaluation is finished. Candidates are to notify their parents when the test ends, select a meeting place, and leave the building.
- C. Only the candidates can get off at the “drop off zone” on the map below and come to the school building to proceed with the registration process. Parents cannot accompany them.
- D. Parents are advised to eat outside as meals are not available on campus. Please refer to the map below which indicates some options for meals.
