



# Admissions Information for HIS Middle and High School for 2025 Spring Semester

Handong International School, a Christian alternative school accredited by the Korean Ministry of Education, will conduct admissions for the 2025 Spring Semester as follows.

#### 1. Available Placements

# 2. Admissions Requirements

- Both the parent(s) and student must be Protestant Christians and consent to the educational philosophy of the school.
- The student must live with at least one parent or grandparent and be able to commute to school OR live in the dormitory\*.
- The student must have completed the grade previous to the grade they are applying for, or have received education that is legally equivalent. However, they should not have already completed the year that they are applying for (for example, a student who has already completed 7th grade may not apply for 7th grade again).
- The student must be capable of coping with HIS middle or high school education.

\* There are 4 spots available in the boys' dormitory and 5 spots available in the girls' dormitory. Students will be selected based on the following order: MK, upper grades, higher grades on admission evaluation.

## 3. Admissions Timeline

  - Application results: Fri, Nov 15, 2024, 17:00
  - Interview and Entrance Exam: Sat, Nov 30, 2024, starting 09:00
  - Parent Interviews: Sat, Nov 30, 2024
- A. Final Results & Enrollment
  - Announcement: Fri, Dec 6, 2024, 14:00
  - Individual notice
  - Enrollment deadline: within 5 days of the notification of acceptance
  - Payment required: Admission fee, Tuition fee, Dormitory fee for 1 semesterer

\*Documents issued abroad must have an Apostille or be notarized by the Korean Embassy. (Exceptions include foreign schools recognized by the Korean Ministry of Education.)

\* After final acceptance, original copies of official school records (transcripts) and certificate of enrollment (or certificate of graduation) must be submitted to the admissions office by the requested deadline. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of admission.

- Refunds: Students who are not accepted in the online application phase will receive a partial refund of ₩100,000

- Applicants that are not suitable for the education program of the school may not be admitted regardless of availability

## C. Evaluation Methods

- Interview
- Time: 15min
- Interviewees will be asked about their understanding of Christianity, spiritual life, school life, relationship with peers, hobbies, plans for studies, and future goals.
- English
- Oral test (Time: 10-15 min.)
- Written test: listening comprehension, reading comprehension, writing (Time: 80 min.)
- Korean
- Time: 45 min

# A. Special Admissions

- Children of employees of HGU
  - A parent is a full-time faculty member (tenure track or non-tenured) of the Handong Global University Foundation
  - A parent is a full-time employee (long-term or temporary contract), teaching assistant, or researcher employed by the Handong Global University Foundation for at least 2 years.
- Missionary kids
  - Both parents must be full-time missionaries, residing outside Korea
  - If currently on sabbatical, parents must have completed at least 3 years of mission work, with the sabbatical period not exceeding 1 year
- B. Applicants that do not fulfill the criteria for Special Admissions will automatically be switched to General Admissions

# 9. Notes for Applicants

- A. Acceptance may be revoked if the contents of the submitted application and documents are found to be falsified.
- B. Admitted applicants must submit tuition fees during the registration period. Failure to do so may result in revoking admission.
- C. The school will provide lunch to the student applicants on the day of the interview and entrance exam.
- D. Submitted documents will not be returned to the applicants.

#### 10. Notes for COVID-19

A. If an applicant has a COVID-19 diagnosis or symptoms, he or she will be required to wear a mask (KF94) and take the exam in the classroom.
