Handong International School, a Christian alternative school accredited by the Korean Ministry of Education, will conduct admissions for the 2024 Spring Semester as follows:

1. Available Vacancy

A few vacancies in 10th grade

2. Admissions Requirements

- Both the parent(s) and student applicant must be Protestant Christians and consent to the educational philosophy of the school.
- The student must have graduated from Middle school, or have received education that is legally equivalent.
- Student applicants must live with at least one of their parents or grandparents and be able to commute to school. Otherwise, they must live in the dormitory.**
- Student applicants must be capable of coping with HIS middle school education.


X There is 1 spot available in the boys' dormitory and 4 spots available in the girls' dormitory. Students will be selected based on the following order: MK, upper grades, higher grades on admission evaluation.

3. Admissions Timeline

- A. Screening Process
 - Online application period: Mon, Jan 6, 2025, 09:00 Mon, Jan 13, 2025, 11:00
 - Application results: Tue, Jan 14, 2025, 14:00
 - Interview and Entrance Exam: Mon, Jan 20, 2025, starting 09:00
 - Parent Interviews: Mon, Jan 20, 2025
- A. Final Results & Enrollment
 - Announcement: Tue, Jan 21, 2025, 14:00
 - Individual notice
 - Enrollment deadline: within 3 days of the notification of acceptance
 - Payment required: Admission fee, Tuition fee, Dormitory fee for 1 semester

- B. Please note that a handling fee is charged when submitting the online application. This fee is non-refundable even should you choose to withdraw your application.

*Documents issued abroad must have an Apostille or be notarized by the Korean Embassy. (Exceptions include foreign schools recognized by the Korean Ministry of Education.)

* After final acceptance, original copies of official school records (transcripts) and certificate of enrollment (or certificate of graduation) must be submitted to the admissions office by the requested deadline. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of admission.

- Refunds: Students who are not accepted in the online application phase will receive a partial refund of ₩100,000





7. Entrance Exam

A. General Information

- Pass/Fail applies to all evaluation areas.
- Applicants that are not suitable for the education program of the school may not be admitted regardless of availability

C. Evaluation Methods

Interview

- Time: 15min.
- Interviewees will be asked about their understanding of Christianity, spiritual life, school life, relationship with peers, hobbies, plans for studies, and future goals.

English

- Oral test (Time: 10-15 min.)
- Written test: listening comprehension, reading comprehension, writing (Time: 80 min.)

Korean

- Time: 45 min.
- Scope of exam and textbooks:

8. Types of Admissions

Types of Admissions		
Special Admissions (Children of employees of HGU Foundation & Missionary kids)	General Admissions	

A. Special Admissions

- Children of employees of HGU
 - A parent is a full-time faculty member (tenure track or non-tenured) of the Handong Global University Foundation
 - A parent is a full-time employee (long-term or temporary contract), teaching assistant, or researcher employed by the Handong Global University Foundation for at least 2 years.
- Missionary kids
 - Both parents must be full-time missionaries, residing outside Korea
 - If currently on sabbatical, parents must have completed at least 3 years of mission work, with the sabbatical period not exceeding 1 year
- B. Applicants that do not fulfill the criteria for Special Admissions will automatically be switched to General Admissions

9. Notes for Applicants

- A. Acceptance may be revoked if the contents of the submitted application and documents are found to be falsified.
- B. Admitted applicants must submit tuition fees during the registration period. Failure to do so may result in revoking admission.
- C. The school will provide lunch to the student applicants on the day of the interview and entrance
- D. Submitted documents will not be returned to the applicants.

10. Notes for COVID-19

A. If an applicant has a COVID-19 diagnosis or symptoms, he or she will be required to wear a mask (KF94) and take the exam in the classroom.
